*Extra dry with a lively acidity and flavours of fig and yellow pear*

### Weingut Leopold 'Classic' Riesling (Austria)

*Fresh lime, lovely minerality and a touch of white pepper  
all balanced with mouth-watering acidity*

*Expressive orchard fruit, juicy, acidity and a flinty-smoky undertone*

*Aromas of red fruit and toasted nuts from aging in French Oak, finishing with a soft round mouthfeel*

*Abundance of cherries and plums on the nose with subtle hints of vanilla and smoky notes*
